Preserve Your Design Intent

The 65-foot center bar light beacon at Pechanga Resort in California fits the classic definition of a centerpiece: the large-scale, brightly lit beacon featuring an infinite array of colors is the first thing guests see as the enter the casino, and it is impossible to keep your eyes off it.

And it almost didn't happen. A mere 12 weeks before the casino opened, the light beacon was in jeopardy of being scrapped, due to potential cost overruns and a contractor's inability to hit the design intent.

Penwal was invited in, and with 3 months to spare it engineered a beautiful, easy-to-install element that saved the design and the day. With turnkey capabilities under one roof, we were able to respond quickly and effectively.
